

Student Responsibilities

- 1. Children are required to arrive to classes at least five minutes before the class starts so that teacher can begin the class on time.
- 2. For educational continuity and knowledge, students are expected to attend all scheduled classes. Excessive absence will be discussed with parents and may result in suspension from the class.
- 3. Students are expected to complete homework assignments and be prepared for their classes with the appropriate books and school materials.
- 4. All children are expected to be respectful of other students, people and property.
- 5. Students are expected to wear attire that is considered appropriate for being at a temple or attending a religious ceremony.
- 6. Occasionally, a student will have difficulties adjusting to the school environment. Students who show consistent patterns of not conforming to Samspra guidelines will be called in for a parent-teacher conference. If the problems continue, student may be suspended from the class.

Parent Responsibilities

- 1. Students are expected to be at Samspra and seated in their class five minutes before class starts. Each class lasts for one hour. Timely drop-off and pick-up is expected.
- 2. Parents are responsible for ensuring that their child is prepared for class (having homework done, getting materials for next class ready, etc.).
- 3. Parents should make a concerted effort to attend any parent-teacher sessions or meetings conducted by Samspra.
- 4. Parents who are interested in observing their child's class should contact the teacher to arrange a mutually agreeable date.
- 5. Any concern related to classroom or learning at Samspra should be discussed with the teacher first and thereafter, submitted to Samspra Director for consideration.
- 6. If your child is going to miss a class, please notify the teacher as soon as you can.
- 7. Usage of cell phones, gaming consoles and other such distracting devices are not permitted in the classrooms during instructions.



- 8. Parents are expected to be respectful of other parents, people, property and events at Samspra and Capital View Center building.
- 9. The Building is secured and locked after 7:00 pm weekdays and during weekends for the safety and security of our students.
- 10. If you need to open the door, please text the teacher and arrive to class on time.
- 11. Parents are required to stay within the premises if your child is less than 12 years of age and or assign a guardian to pick up and drop your child.
- 12. Teachers are responsible of the student during class times. Timely pick up arrival is appreciated.
- 13. Parents are responsible for sending in a healthy snack and a water bottle for their child. Snacks must be strictly vegetarian.
- 14. Students are expected to wear attire that is considered appropriate for the school and for the classes they are in.
- 15. Please let the teachers know of anything in your child's life which may affect his/her school experience, e.g. death of a relative, illness, new sibling, death of a pet, etc.

Teacher Responsibilities

- **1.** Teachers arrive to the class at least 10 minutes before student arrival and are prepared for the class.
- **2.** Teachers are responsible for the safety, security and proper learning of the student during class.
- **3.** Proper age and level appropriate curriculum should be in place and lessons plans and submitted to Samspra.
- **4.** Parent and teacher communication is open and teacher periodically updates teachers of the student progress.
- **5.** Teacher will offer make up classes upon teacher's absence or cancellation of the class, at a time that is mutually convenient.



- **6.** Teachers are responsible of keeping record of student attendance and submitting to Samspra after each class.
- **7.** Safety is our priority. Teachers will update and discuss with parents and students any change in plans to their class or access to the entrance door policy.
- 8. Teachers are required to be on time and attend all teachers' meetings and school related events.

Payments & Refund Policy

- One-time annual non-refundable fee is due at the time of registration.
- Both Monthly and Semester pay option is available. Semester pay has a small discount.
- Fees are not refunded after the 4th classes in a semester. Semester fee
 can be prorated before mid-semester. After which students will
 automatically fall under monthly pay.
- Fees are due in the beginning of each semester or each month
- Please see our acceptable form of payment for options.
- Some classes have supply fee apart from the class fee. Supply fee can be paid to the teacher directly.
